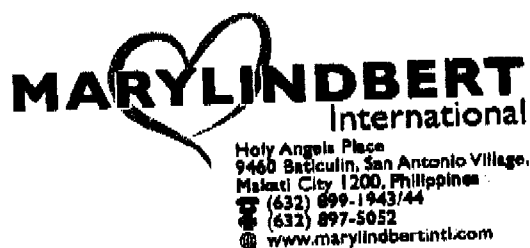

BAYAD CENTER SAPAT DAPAT QUIZ BEE COMPETITION

The BAYAD CENTER "SAPAT DAPAT" Comprehensive School Program (CSP) in partnership with MARYLINDBERT INTERNATIONAL and the DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION will conduct the BAYAD CENTER SAPAT DAPAT Quiz Bee Competition on March 12, 2020 at Guadalupe Elementary School, Cebu City, Cebu.

This special event is sponsored by BAYAD CENTER a subsidiary of MERALCO. It is an offshoot of a series of demonstration lessons on Financial Literacy thus making it as a Laboratory of Life of students in Mathematics.

The Competition shall be composed of three (3) rounds namely:

1 st Round	School Level	Choosing of School Contestant/ Representative
2 nd Round	Division Level (Semi-finals)	Division to Choose 3 Finalists/Representatives for the Regional Final Contest (Division to Conduct Eliminations)
3 rd Round	Regional Level (Finals)	Quiz Bee Competition

Questions of all rounds shall revolve around the topic "FINANCIAL LITERACY"

The 1st Round (Knock-Out Round) will be conducted by the school officials (public and private schools). The schedule of the competition is upon the discretion of the school officials however, it should be conducted a month before the schedule of the Final Competition.

Participants will be limited to Junior and Senior High School students. All participating schools in the 1st Round Competition will prepare a 50-item test on Financial Literacy. The student garnering the highest score shall represent the school.

The Semi-Finals will be conducted by the concerned Divisions of the Region. The schools to compete in the Regional Level (Finals Round) will be submitted by the Division Offices to MaryLindbert Int'l via email to contest.marylindbertintl@marylindbertintl.com or marygrace.rancio@marylindbertintl.com for MaryLindbert Int'l will coordinate.

The Finals will be conducted in Guadalupe Elementary School, Cebu City, Cebu.

Mechanics:

1. The SAPAT DAPAT Quiz Bee is divided into three (3) rounds: the EASY, AVERAGE and DIFFICULT rounds.

- The contestants should be at the place of the competition thirty (30) minutes before the scheduled time. Immediate disqualification will be implemented to those contestants who failed to show up ten (10) minutes after the supposed start of the Quiz Bee.
- Clarification regarding the rules of the competition shall be entertained by the Committee before the start of the contest.
- Each contestant will be provided with a competition number and a white board with a board marker and eraser.
- The first ten (10) Easy Questions will be read one at a time by the Quiz-Master. Questions will be read twice. When the Quiz-Master says "GO" only then should the participants start writing on their white board. The members of the team may consult each other to reach the best answer.
- When done, all teams should raise their pens and show their final answer at the signal "NOW".

- Every correct answer in the EASY Round is worth one (1) point. Wrong spelling will be considered "WRONG".
- The next ten (10) questions will be drawn from the AVERAGE items. Every correct answer is worth three (3) points.
- The last ten (10) questions will be taken from the DIFFICULT item bank. Every correct answer is worth five (5) points.
- The five (5) contestants with the highest total scores shall be declared:
 - 1st Place
 - 2nd Place
 - 3rd Place
 - 4th Place
 - 5th Place
- Should a tie exist, the match shall go into a **SUDDEN DEATH**. The first contestant to answer two (2) questions correctly shall be declared the winner of the tie.
- No questions shall be entertained during the contest proper.
- Misbehavior of an individual contestant during the contest is a sufficient condition for the team's disqualification.
