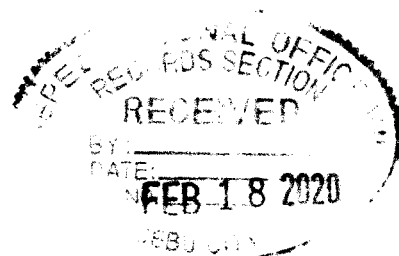
In this regard, we wish to request your endorsement for the support and participation of all the concerned public and private secondary schools in Region VII in accordance with pertinent Department of Education guidelines.

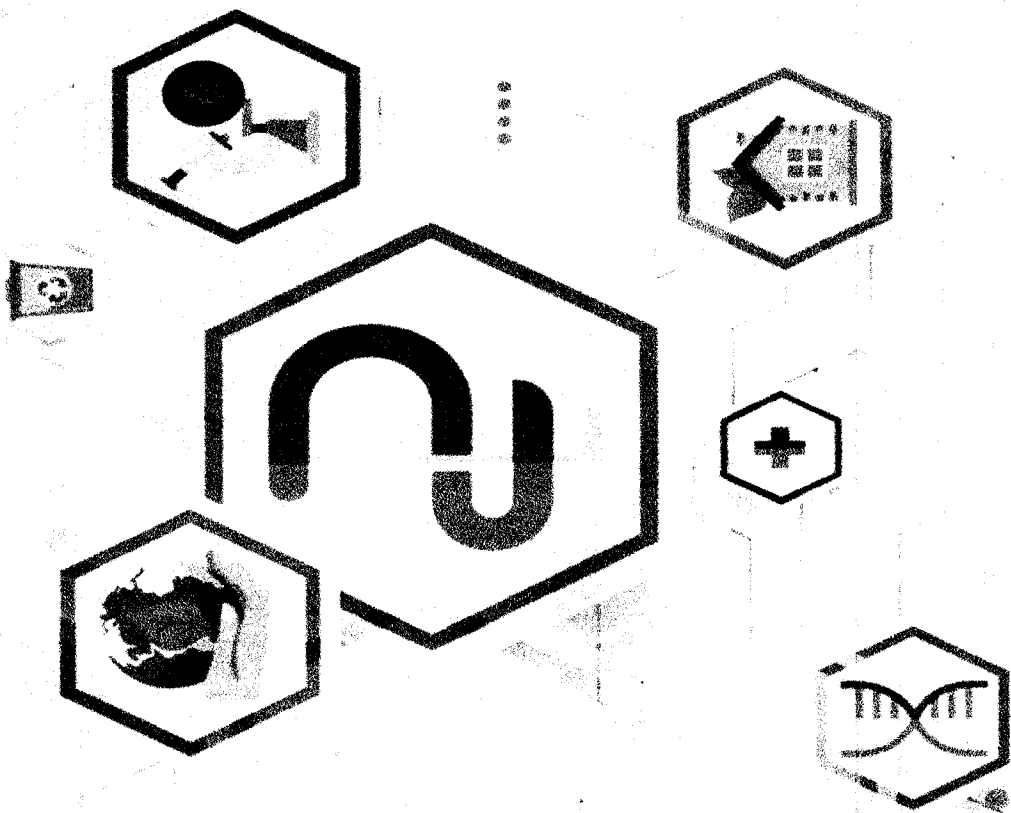
