MHCC RATIONALE

BACKGROUND:

The Mary Help of Christians Crusades (MHCC) is the implementation arm for the youth of the Alliance of the Holy Family International (AHFI), a movement dedicated for the sanctification of families, youth, clergy, and media. The MHCC is named in honor of Mary Help of Christians as evidence to the motherly concern and help she is manifesting. It is a non-profit, non-stock, cultural, charitable, and apostolic organization for the services of the young people of society.

SITUATIONAL ANALYSIS:

The Popes since Saint John Paul II's pontificate have been encouraging us to give particular attention to the young people. They are the future. However, if we look at the degradation of the morality in today's culture and how the young have to face so much violence, manipulation and immorality on a daily basis we seek to help form them to face these obstacles and to become committed Christian leaders with strong moral values through the Mary Help of Christians Crusade (MHCC).
