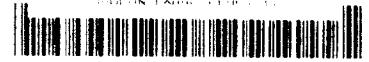

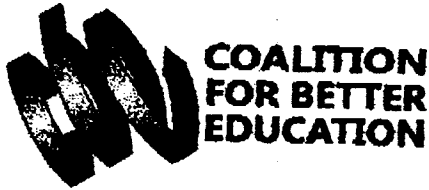


Dear Dr. Dulangon,
