





**DATA GATHERING FOR THE RESEARCH-BASED INNOVATION/INTERVENTION ROADMAP  
FOR DEVELOPING INNOVATIVE SCHOOLS BY 2013-2015 AND BEYOND  
FOR CENTRAL VISAYAS**

1. This Office would like to inform you that DepEd Region VII is currently conducting a "Research-Based Innovation Roadmap for Developing Innovative Schools by 2013 and Beyond for Central Visayas" to empower and enable S & T Related Schools to prepare for the implementation of the Senior High Schools in the K to 12 Basic Education Program and develop 21st Century Schools for the 21st Century Professions and Highly-Skilled Value-Diven Filipino in the Workplace in business and entrepreneurship and make every learner a trully functionally literate Filipino.
2. A research team from the regional office, with the Division Planning Officer will gather relevant data from the randomly sampled schools between February 21 to March 8, 2013.
3. For the orientation and preliminary gathering activities, School Heads of the randomly selected schools are requested to attend said activities, together with their a.) SSG President/Representative; b.) one (1) Teacher; c.) PTA President/Representative; d.) one (1) LGU Representative and e.) one (1) Community Leader/Member.
4. Attached are the list of sampled schools and the schedule for data gathering activities, for guidance and information.
5. Travelling and other incidental expenses for the participants shall be charged to local school/MOOE funds, while travelling, per diem and other incidental expenses incurred by the Division Planning Officer shall be charged to the Division funds, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. This Memorandum will serve as Authority to Travel.
7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance to this Memorandum is desired.
