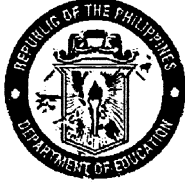

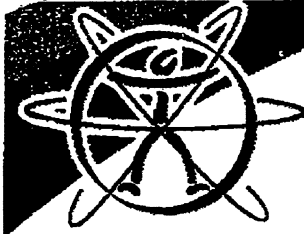

Registration Fee will cover board and lodging from dinner of April 9, 2013 until dinner of April 12, 2013, NYSTESC kits, shirts, educational trip expenses, and insurance. Only reserved participants will be accepted. In case of back-out participants, please inform the National Office on or before March 18, 2013. Only students of the same school may become replacements for the back-out participant.

**2. The registration fee (non-refundable) is 5500 php for PSYSC affiliated schools and 8000 php for non-affiliated schools.**

**3. Deadline for registration is on March 18, 2013. A reservation of 750 php (deductible from Registration fee) is required and is payable at land bank account number 0702-1020-65 or remitted through Postal Money Order (PMO) payable only to the Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs.**

**4. This will cover board and lodging from dinner of April 9, 2013 until dinner of April 12, 2013, CAMP kits, shirt, educational trip expenses and insurance. Only participants who have paid the reservation fee will be accepted. In case of back-out participants, please inform the National office on or before March 18, 2013. Only students of the same school may become replacements for the back-out participants.**

**5. Earlier submission of all requirements (forms for the paid reservation fees, registration forms, and all other requirements) will be given priority on the room assignments. Dates of payments will be validated through the date written on the deposit slip.**

**6.
