1. As provided for in Section IV Part D of DepEd Order No. 11, s. 2013 entitled *Policies and Guidelines on the Implementation of the GASTPE Program Effective School Year 2013-2014*, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Office of Planning Service (OPS) and the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE), have determined the distribution of Grade 7 slots to Education Service Contracting (ESC)-participating secondary schools based on shortage and performance-based standards.
2. The total number of Grade 7 slots is comprised of the following: (a) the actual number of Grade 7 grantees in the previous school year (fixed slots); and (b) additional slots, which are granted to participating secondary schools in areas where there is serious overcrowding and/or to participating secondary schools which have achieved certification/accreditation ratings stated in DepEd Order No. 11, s. 2013. Certification/Accreditation ratings as of March 18, 2013 shall serve as basis for the allocation of additional slots.
3. The distribution of Grade 7 slots by region, by division and by municipality is contained in the enclosure.
4. Schools may check their individual allocations for School Year (SY) 2013-2014 through their online account at the FAPE website: [www.fape.org.ph](http://www.fape.org.ph). A general listing of all participating schools and their slots allocations is also available on the FAPE website.

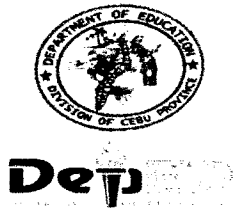
