2013 BRIGADA ESKWELA LAUNCHING AND CARAVAN

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 40, s. 2013, the Department of Education will be implementing this year's Brigada Eskwela, also known as the National Schools Maintenance Week on May 20-25, 2013. This school maintenance activity of the Department engages all education stakeholders to make sure that all public schools facilities are being prepared in time for the coming school opening.
- 2. Relative to this, a Division-wide Caravan will be initiated on May 20, 2013 (Monday) to launch the first day of Brigada Eskwela 2013. This activity will begin at 7:00 AM, with the following routes: North Consolacion to Balamban and South Minglanilla to Sibonga. A short program or official kick-off ceremony at the first stop of both teams will signal the start of the weeklong undertaking.
- 3. Actual repairs of broken chairs and windows, as well as repainting of classrooms and school facilities, including the clean-up of rooms and school surroundings should be done by the stakeholders in the schools. Clean up will also be initiated in the Division Office as the share of Non Teaching Personnel to this activity.
- 4. Enclosed is a detailed list of routes and team members for the Caravan. (Encl. No. 1).
- 5. Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be chargeable against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum for the proper guidance of all concerned is desired.
