

We are pleased to inform your Office that the Nueva Ecija University of Science and Technology will organize and spearhead the National Conference on School Security Management, with the theme "*Building a Caring Culture through a Secure and Safe School Environment*." This nation-wide undertaking will be held on May 28-30, 2013 at Hotel Stotsenberg, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga

This three-day national Conference aims to: (1) Determine the problems in school that threaten the lives and security of persons, properties, tranquility and conduciveness to learning, interpersonal relationship among the people in the school community, and find solutions to address these problems; (2) Serve as forum for the sharing of best practices, ideas and experiences regarding school security management; and (3) Serve as venue for the presentation of researches conducted relative to school security management.

The research paper will be evaluated and included in the Souvenir Program, if so such, kindly submit a copy of the same via e-mail on or before May 10, 2013.

To help defray the expenses for food, hotel accommodation for two nights, airfare and materials, honorarium for the speakers and other operating expenses, there will be a registration fee of PHP 7,000.00 per participant.
