REITERATING SCHOOL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION MEASURES


To: Schools Division/City Superintendents
Officers-in-Charge of Interior and Regular Divisions
All Others Concerned

1. Republic Act No.10121 states the policy of the government that disaster risk reduction (DRR) be mainstreamed in the country's development process by institutionalizing DRR policies, structures, coordination mechanisms and programs in policy formulation, socioeconomic development, planning, budgeting, and governance, particularly in the areas of environment, agriculture, water, energy, health, education, poverty reduction, land-use and urban planning, and public infrastructure and housing, among others.
2. The Department of Education reiterates its policies on DRR with the guidance provided by DepEd Memorandum No. 297 series of 2008 under "Utilization of the Disaster Risk Reduction Manual In the School System Effective SY 2008-2009."
3. As such, all schools are required to conduct the following essential disaster risk reduction measures during the first month of the school opening to ensure the safety and protection of our school children and personnel.
 - a. Organize and capacitate a school disaster risk reduction committee (SDRRC)
 - b. The SDRRCs must have a DRR Plan which must be coordinated with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (LDRRMC)
 - c. The School DRR Plan must prepare for ensuring continuity of education during emergencies and may prepare for the following:
 - i. Identification and preparation for temporary learning spaces
 - ii. Alternative delivery of formal education

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- d. SDRRCs must coordinate the conduct of appropriate drills such as the following:
 - i. Evacuation drills (Earthquake drill, tsunami drill, fire drill, flood drill, landslide)
 - ii. Lock down drills (security breach or school violence threat)
4. A copy of the DepEd DRR Manual may be sourced from under resources download page.
5. All regional DRR focal persons must consolidate and submit the DRRM compliance monitoring (Annex A) form to the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office on or before August 30, 2013.
6. Through this monitoring tool, DRRMO would like to get baseline information on the status of the following: (a) creation and activation of School Disaster Risk Reduction Committees; (b) crafting and implementation of the Disaster Risk Reduction Plans; (c) conduct and evacuation and lockdown drills and; (d) other disaster preparedness measures, such as identification of temporary learning spaces and alternative delivery of formal education; (e) DRR/ CCA reference materials available and used in the schools; (f) capacity building programs on DRR and CCA; (g) existing programs on DRR and CCA.
7. To facilitate efficient and timely communication regarding DRR concerns, schools are requested to submit the names of their DRR Focal person and their alternates together with their functions and complete contact details to DRRMO on or before July 15, 2013.
8. For dissemination and strict compliance of all concerned.
