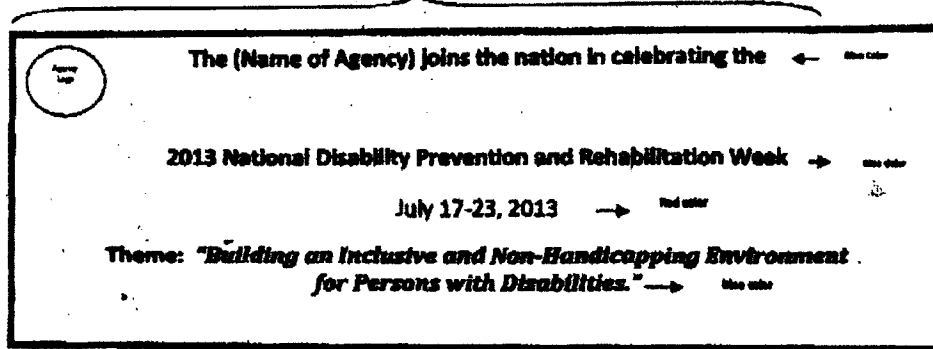
**PROMOTIONAL EFFORTS AND PUBLICITY**

As a way to generate wide publicity of the weeklong celebration, various promotional efforts will be undertaken by NCDA. Media networks and practitioners will be tapped to promote the celebration through the broadcast and print channels. Guestings of NCDA officials in broadcast networks will be facilitated and press releases will be prepared that will be syndicated in the print media. Media crew will also be invited to cover the activities that will be conducted in specified venues.

In addition, tarpaulins and/or streamers with prescribed texts will be hanged in conspicuous places of public offices, plazas, schools, provincial capitols, city/municipal/barangay halls, hospitals and in venues where the activities are currently held. For purposes of uniformity, a white cloth and/or tarpaulin streamer with a blue background, specific dimensions and text prescribed hereunder shall be strictly observed and followed.
