 - Curriculum used and subjects taught by the Chinese Volunteer teachers; and
 - How the arrangement relate with the requirement of the PRC for a permit to teach even for a short term.
3. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.

**URGENT SUBMISSION OF DATA ON CHINESE VOLUNTEER TEACHERS
DEPLOYED IN PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

1. Per DepEd Memorandum from Usec. Mario A. Deriquito, Undersecretary of Partnerships and External Linkages which was faxed to this Office on July 8, 2013, the Embassy of China in the Philippines and the Filipino-Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Inc. (FCCCII) has collaborated to promote and enhance Chinese language, culture and knowledge in the Philippines through educational institutions. Under this partnership, a total of fifty (50) Chinese volunteers have been reported to have been deployed to various private and public schools in the country. Attached is the list of Chinese volunteer teachers and areas of deployment (excluding those who failed to be reported).

2. In an inter-agency meeting convened by the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), the participants were informed of the Chinese government's plan to send another batch of Chinese volunteer teachers to the country. With this information, concerns were expressed on the rising number of Chinese volunteer teachers who are not part of any specific program of this Department. Under our Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL) - Chinese Mandarin, there are only four (4) recognized Chinese volunteer teachers teaching Chinese language.

3. In this regard, the Department of Education through the Regional Office requires the Schools Division Superintendents thru their EPS in-charge of the Private Schools, SPFL coordinator or anybody to help them provide the following data:

- List of names and profile of all past and present Chinese volunteer teachers assigned in both public and private elementary and secondary schools (Chinese, Filipino, and/or Chinese-Filipino schools with Chinese class/course offerings) in your division;
- Assessment Report on the need or demand for Chinese volunteer teachers in the schools offering Chinese classes (public and private elementary and secondary schools) in your division;
- Description of the relationship of the schools with the FCCCII and provide the idea as to who signified interest to engage the Chinese volunteer teachers (Ex. Is it the FCCCII or the school?);
- Curriculum used and subjects taught by the Chinese Volunteer teachers; and
- How the arrangement relate with the requirement of the PRC for a permit to teach even for a short term. *"Educating for a Strong Republic"*

It would further help concerned government agencies in determining the legality or necessity of the Chinese volunteer teachers if additional information could be provided such as basis of their deployment, whether the schools had requested for the said volunteer teachers or FCCCII had offered them. Other information which may be relevant or important will greatly help in addressing the issues at hand.

6. Preferential attention on this matter is highly requested as the needed information will serve as inputs in the next inter-agency meeting to be called by DFA.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
