**OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL DISASTER CONSCIOUSNESS MONTH**

Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads

1. Per Office Order from DepEd Central Office received by this Office on June 27, 2013, and in accordance with Executive Order No. 137 of 1999 "Declaring the Month of July Every Year as National Disaster Consciousness Month", the National Disaster Consciousness Month will be observed from July 1-31, 2013. All schools are directed to plan and undertake significant and meaningful activities anchored on disaster preparedness.
2. This year's observance of National Disaster Consciousness Month theme is "Ligtas Na Bayan, Maunlad na Pamayanan". All activities to be undertaken during the celebration shall be related to the theme. The following are the suggested program/projects/activities in order to sustain disaster preparedness awareness campaign in the school level, to wit:
  - a. Evacuation drills (earthquake, flood, tsunami, landslide and fire drills)
  - b. Lesson integration in all learning areas
  - c. Slogan making, poster making, essay writing contests
  - d. Film showing
3. Flag raising ceremony with a message of disaster-preparedness by the head of office or school principal is on July 8, 2013.
4. Signage of the celebration's theme to be prominently displayed in schools is recommended.
