

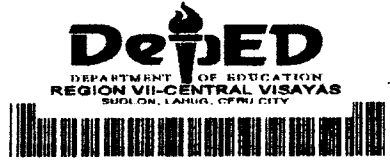

ITEACH MATH TEACHERS TRAINING
(Improving Technology-Enhanced Activities for Creative Honing
of Mathematics Skills)

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools

1. In view of the successful pilot run of the joint project of the Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI), Advanced Science and Technology Institute (ASTI), Philippine Council for Industry, Energy and Emerging Technology Research and Development (PCIETRD), Department of Education-Bureau of Elementary Education (DepEd-BEE) and the University of the Philippines-National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education Development (UP-NISMED) in ten elementary schools nationwide, a three-day teachers' training entitled **ITEACH Math Teachers Training (Improving Technology-Enhanced Activities for Creative Honing of Mathematics Skills)** will be conducted in cluster areas nationwide. The dates and venues for the cluster trainings shall be announced later.

2. The Training aims to:

- a. build and strengthen the capacity of the teachers and their respective schools in using and learning the contents of the interactive Grade I Mathematics courseware; and
- b. train them in applying and teaching the content of the interactive Grade I Mathematics courseware.

3. This activity will be participated in by 590 Grade I teachers from the 16 regions nationwide. The regional offices (ROs) are requested to verify the names of teachers listed in the enclosure. However, the slots to be identified by the ROs should be submitted to the Staff Development Division (SDD)-BEE on or before **June 15, 2013**.

4. The four trainers from the UP-NISMED will facilitate the sessions on teaching the ten lessons with 16 activities of the Grade I Mathematics courseware which will serve as either enhancement or enrichment materials for teaching Grade I Mathematics.

5. The expenses for the training, board and lodging, and transportation of the participants and DepEd-BEE project staff shall be shouldered by the DOST-PCIETRD. Travel expenses using the most economical round trip (RT) route only shall be reimbursed at the specified venue during the training subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

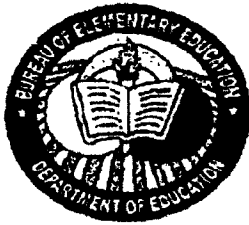
