STC CEBU STAGES ZARZUELA: DALAGANG BUKID

August is a month of celebrating our Filipino roots and in taking pride of what's Filipino. So, what better way to fully enjoy *Buwon ng Wika*, than to appreciate Filipino arts and music in one musical stage play!

In 80 years of Science, Virtue and the Arts, St. Theresa's College-Cebu celebrates the beauty of Art, guided by her 80th year anniversary theme: STC Cebu @80: Vision, Values and Vitality, by a beautiful drama and musical art form, the Zarzuela.

The Zarzuela is a Spanish-lyric dramatic genre that alternates between spoken and sung scenes as well as dance. It was introduced to the Philippines in the 19th century by Spanish director, Alejandro Cubero. As it found interest in the hearts of Filipinos, it became endearingly called as *sarsuwelo* then had vernacular adaptations not long after. It soon lost its luster in the 1930s on the dawn of the vaudeville and the cinemas. Today, it is a long forgotten piece of creative history which reflects Filipino ingenuity and brilliance.

With the awareness of its splendor, STC-Cebu aims to enhance knowledge and bring understanding, appreciation and love of our rich Filipino culture by making it accessible to both the youth and the Cebuano community.

STC-Cebu will immortalize Hemogenes Ilagan's zarzuela, *Dalagang Bukid*, with music composed by Leon Ignacion in 1919. Set in the American occupation, *Dalagang Bukid* is the most popular zarzuela in Filipino history.

Our culture is our identity, our brand and our pride. It is the very core of a Filipino's passion as it shapes who we are. The story mirrors Filipinos customs, traditions and faith. It pictures the Filipino culture that is unique and special as it unfolds on stage. Religious processions, coronation of festival queens and the *rigodon de honor* are featured in the play which features Filipinos' affinity for pageantry. Dalagang Bukid perfectly showcases how optimistic Filipinos are despite adversities and problems.

Aside from culture, our language is also our identity. It is our means of communication to prosper and succeed. We find comfort in our language for it is the only way we are understood and belonged. Dalagang Bukid serves as a platform for better appreciation of our mother tongue especially for the youth. The play will be in Cebuano and songs will be in the traditional Filipino love song genre, the Kundiman.

Parents will be delighted to know that this is not just a play to entertain, but *Dalagang Bukid* is a story filled with Filipino values. This is important as the changing times have challenged our values and beliefs. *Dalagang Bukid* shows an ideal Filipino man in the character of Cipriano who embodies righteousness and trust. Angelita on the other hand demonstrates every Filipina's deep love for family and respect for elders and through actions and words. Both characters serve as inspiration to young men and women of today.

Will love endure lies and temptations? Find out if Cipriano will be able to fight his love for Angelita or will the wealthy old man's slick tricks lose his chances for Angelita's love? End all your speculations and watch this entertaining play of love, trust and perseverance. *Dalagang Bukid* will be staged at the Marie Adolphine Hall (STC Auditorium) on August 28- 31, 2013.
