We would like to formally invite your Department/Office/Organization to nominate candidate/s for 2-year Masteral Programs under the Japanese Grant Aid for Human Resource Development Scholarship (JDS) Project for Japanese Academic Year 2014-2015.

As discussed in previous years, the framework of the JDS Program under the new scheme that covers fiscal years 2011-2014 will continue to be adopted for this (now the 12th) batch of fellows. This means that a single program is designed to have twenty (20) fellows per batch each year with identified target organizations, accepting Japanese universities and field of studies. Said scheme ensures effectiveness and efficiencies of the Program. Moreover, under this scheme, the target organizations may program their perspective candidates and may continue to nominate qualified candidates in the succeeding batch/es.

Promotion seminars are scheduled to be held in Central Luzon (Subic) and Manila (Quezon City) within the 5th week of August 2013, as well as in the Visayas (Cebu) and Northern Luzon within the 2nd week of September 2013. The deadline for submission of nomination of candidate/s for this batch is on **31 October 2013 (4:00pm)**. In relation, kindly note the following important reminders:

- a. The applications should be submitted to the JICE JDS Project Office in the Philippines either personally or by mail/courier;
- b. Local Government Units (LGUs) and State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) are requested to directly send nominations to JICE, copy furnished the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED)-International Affairs Office, respectively; and
- c. Late submission and incomplete application documents will NOT be accepted.

The detailed information on the nomination/qualification requirements, program information and procedures, as well as updates on the subprograms and components is specified in the JDS promotion materials provided during the seminars.
