**CORRIGENDUM TO REGIONAL MEMORANDUM NO. 573,s. 2013
(WORLD FOOD DAY ON-THE-SPOT MOSAIC MAKING CONTEST)**

To: Schools Division Superintendents/Officers-in-Charge

1. As part of the worldwide celebration, the Department of Agriculture-Regional Field Units(DA-RFU 7), in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd), and the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization will conduct the "World Food Day 2013 National On-the-Spot Mosaic Making Contest" that will be held in Schools, District, Division and Regional levels.
2. The contest is open to all Grades IV to VI elementary pupils (not older than 12 years old and certified by the school principal) enrolled in any public and DepEd-accredited private elementary schools nationwide. Previous National Winners are disqualified to participate at any level of this contest.
3. The mosaic entry shall be an original creation of eligible participants, depicting the central theme of the World Food Day 2013 celebration: "Sustainable Food Systems for Food Security and Nutrition".
4. The contest elimination process shall be done at every level: School, District, Division and Regional following the schedules below:

School Level	September 6, 2013 (Friday)
District Level	September 13, 2013(Friday)
Division Level	September 20, 2013(Friday)
Regional Level	September 27, 2013(Friday)
National Level	October 11, 2013(Friday)
-Contest Proper	8:00 AM – 4:00 PM
-Judging Proper	4:00 PM – 5:00 PM

Only one (1) shall be declared winner in the Regional Level and he/she shall receive Three Thousand Pesos (P 3,000.00) from DA-Regional Field Units. Attached is the General Guidelines of the World Food Day 2013 "Nationwide On-the-Spot Mosaic Making Contest".

A. School Level: September 6, 2013

1. Materials to be used include an illustration board (20" x 30") to be provided by the Contest Committee, and any art medium, except oil and water color, and a combination of agricultural and fishery products (e.g. palay grains, mungo, squash seeds, corn kernels/husks, sea shells, dried seaweeds, etc.) which shall be provided by the participants;
2. The theme should be incorporated on the mosaic as part of its design. A mosaic with no indicated theme shall be disqualified.
3. The participant/contestant shall fill out an entry form which shall also include the brief description/explanation of the finished design written in English or Filipino to be pasted at the back of the mosaic.
4. Winners of each level shall be given Certificates of Merit by the participating school.
5. Deadline of submission of winning posters to the DepEd-District Office is on September 9, 2013.

*Note: The three (3) winning entries shall compete for the district level.

B. District level: September 13, 2013

1. The best three (3) entries from each school shall be eligible for the District Level competition.
2. The competing mosaics shall be judged at the DepEd-District Office, where a panel of judges shall select the best three (3) entries.
3. The winners shall be awarded Certificates/Medals of Merit from the District Office.

C. Division Level: September 23, 2013

1. The best three (3) mosaics from each district shall be eligible for the Division Level.
2. The competing mosaics shall be judged at the DepEd-Division Office, where a panel of judges shall select the best three (3) entries.
3. The winners shall be awarded Certificates/Medals of Merit from the Division Office.
4. The deadline of submission of winning entries to the DepEd-Regional Office is on September 23, 2013.

D. Regional level: September 27, 2013

1. The three (3) winners in the Division Level are eligible to participate in the Regional level competition. They shall bring their mosaics to the regional level.
2. The contestant shall do an entirely different design from the one he/she has done in the division level.
3. The regional level shall be conducted on-the-spot where a panel of judges shall select the best entries representing the region at the national competition.
4. Only one (1) shall be declared winner and he/she shall receive Five Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) from DA - Regional Field Units.
5. The DA's RFO shall send a photo of the regional winning entry thru email to the Secretariat (jagopelata@yahoo.com or materialcenter@yahoo.com) after the judging.
6. The regional winner shall be accompanied by onespot presenter.
