We are pleased to announce that the History Department in collaboration with the Humanities and Filipino Departments of the University of Asia and the Pacific (UA&P) College of Arts and Sciences will hold ***Pag-ibig sa Tinubuang Bayan: A Re-examination of Bonifacio's Ideas on Patriotism, Citizenship and Nation-building, Seminar and Workshop for Social Studies and History Teachers***. The seminar-workshop is a tribute to national hero Andres Bonifacio, whose 150th birth anniversary will be celebrated on November 30, 2013. The activity will run from November 7 to 9, 2013 at the Li Seng Giap Auditorium, University of Asia and the Pacific Campus, Pearl Drive, Ortigas Complex, Pasig City.

The objectives of the Seminar- Workshop are the following:

1. To help the participants understand the historical and cultural context of Andres Bonifacio, the Katipunan and the Revolution.
2. To examine the writings of Andres Bonifacio and other primary sources in the context of patriotism, citizenship and nation building.
3. To create awareness, based on the study and analysis of primary sources, about Andres Bonifacio's contribution to the emergence of a national consciousness.

The lecture speakers include: Dr. Bernardita Reyes Churchill, President of the Philippine National Historical Society; Rizal and Gawad Balagtas Awardee, Dr. Paul A. Dumol; and Metrobank Outstanding teacher Dr. Leodivico Lacsamana, among others.

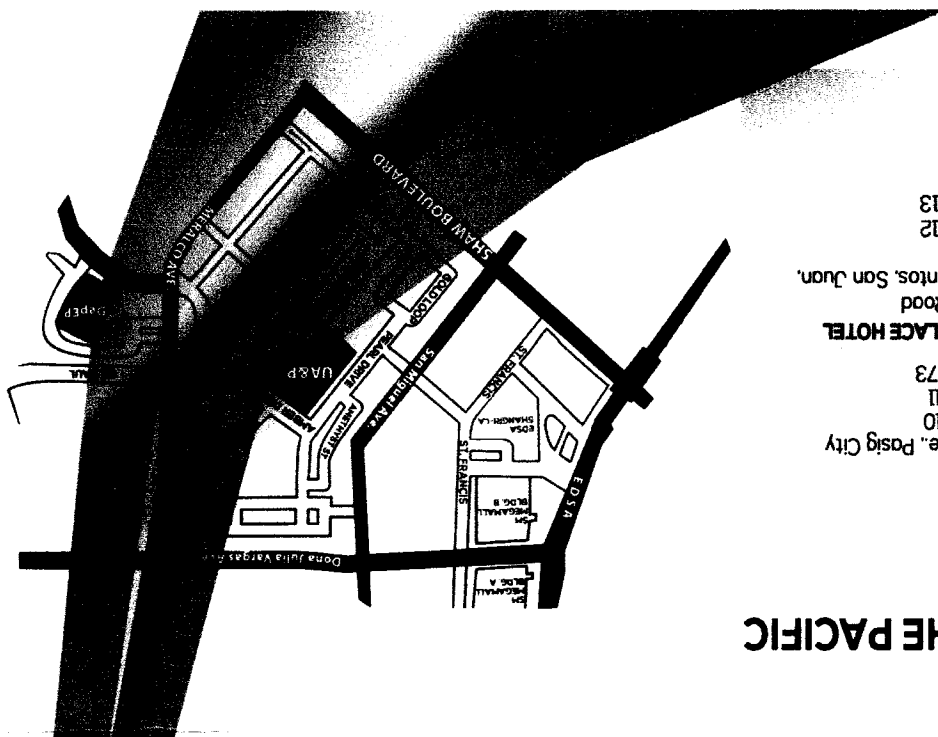
