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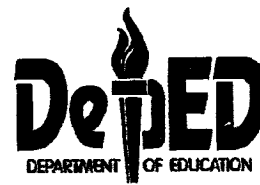

DATE: August 30, 2013

In 2011, the United Nations (UN) General Assembly announced the re-establishment of the observance of the International Day of the Girl Child every October 11th of each year. The purpose is to "promote girls' rights and to highlight the gender inequalities that remain between boys and girls" up to this day.

In observance of this day, Intel Philippines proposes to show a full length movie entitled "Girls Rising" in selected public elementary and high schools across the country to increase awareness among our female students, their parents, and their communities. Intel has communicated with us on this proposal and they are aware of our existing policies on film viewing and similar activities in our public schools.

The selection of schools where the film will be shown will be based on the agreement between Intel Philippines and the Regional Offices. Intel shall be coordinating closely with the regional offices on this matter. Participation is purely voluntary.
