1. Abot-Alam is a nationwide program with the vision of helping our community-based youth through opportunities for education, possible career and employment.
2. The DepED's goal and commitment includes the following:
 - To reach One (1) Million OSYs in 2014 and reintegrate them to education
 - Use existing learning resources and development of new ones
 - Incorporating Abot-Alam into local DepEd KPAs
 - Resource allocation and mobilization
 - National level advocacy campaign to generate support for the program
3. The main objective of the program is to reintegrate out-of-school youth to education, employment, and entrepreneurship by providing opportunities through various offerings.
