Dear **Dr. Monisit**:

Please be informed that the Amount of **Three Million Six Hundred Sixty Six Thousand Pesos (Php 3,666,000.00)** with **Sub-ARO No. SHNC-7-13-0065 dated May 20, 2013** was transferred to you for the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) in 21 selected schools in your division. SBFP is intended for the feeding of severely wasted Kinder to Grade VI pupils for 120 days utilizing locally available foods. Checks are expected to be issued to the School Heads subject to procurement, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations. The schools are expected to plan and procure the ingredients of the meals to be served to the beneficiaries.

It is requested that all measures be done to ensure that funds are utilized on time according to its purpose and for the funds to be obligated before the year ends because DBM already announced that there is no continuing appropriation for CY 2014. It is highly enjoined that feeding commence in August for easier compliance to the 120 feeding days cycle. Submission of SBFP Terminal Report is expected by March of 2014.
