**CONDUCT OF THE "2013-2014 AGRI-PINOY GULAYAN SA PAARALAN
(AG-GPP) BEST IMPLEMENTORS" IN ALL PUBLIC
ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS**



1. This Office announces the conduct of the "2013-2014 Agri-Pinoy Gulayan sa Paaralan Best Implementors" in all public and secondary schools.
2. District EPP and Municipal TLE Coordinators, EPP and TLE teachers should refer to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in the dissemination of its content signed by DepEd Secretary Armin Luistro and Secretary Proceso Alcala of the Department Agriculture.
3. Each district should select one (1) representative for small schools category and two (2) for big schools category including the central schools. For the secondary level, only one should be selected in every municipality. The evaluation will start at the end of November until the last week of March, 2013.
4. The evaluators are composed of the members of the Regional and Division Technical Working Groups as found in the MOU.
5. The following are the bases in selecting the best implementers:
 - School shall have a minimum of 200 square meters area. For schools without available space/flooded area, they can adopt container gardening;
 - School gardens shall be continuously maintained and sustained thru establishment of nurseries, waste management, best practices on organic farming, landscaping (planting with vegetables together with

ornamental plants), Bio-intensive, multiple cropping and seed production partnership with stakeholders.

- Utilization of garden yields for feeding and excess vegetables may be sold to generate income to be used in buying other ingredients and other planting needs;
- Advocacy campaign like conducting contests in food production, poster/ slogan writing/drawing, cooking contests and others to create awareness among learners, ALS, 4Ps and other stakeholders, and
- School shall have records of its implementation and shall be punctual in submitting reports in all greening /AG-GPP in the Division Office

3. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
