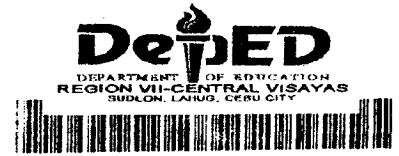

2013 EDUCATION WEEK CELEBRATION

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 2399 dated February 25, 1985 designating the *2nd Week of December of every year as Education Week*, the Department of Education (DepEd) shall celebrate the **2013 Education Week** nationwide with the theme *"K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum: Developing Lifelong Learners Towards Inclusive Growth and Nation-Building"* on December 9-13, 2013.
2. The Celebration aims to:
 - a. provide awareness among stakeholders on the role of education as a stimulus towards national development;
 - b. reaffirm and emphasize the role of education in empowering and developing the young to be productive citizens of the country and responsive to the needs of the times;
 - c. drum up support and cooperation among stakeholders for the implementation of the Enhanced Basic Education Program (K to 12);
 - d. strengthen cooperation among stakeholders in education to support the necessary and significant changes to achieve quality and relevant education; and
 - e. inspire every educator to do more for the schoolchildren to ensure their future.
3. Regional Directors (RDs) and Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs) are enjoined to take active lead in the weeklong Celebration.
4. All schools officials are encouraged to conduct simple and austere programs and activities during the week consistent with the theme and objectives of this year's Celebration. Enclosed is the suggested list of activities, which may be conducted by all DepEd offices and schools.
5. Necessary arrangement shall be made to enable teachers, students and pupils to participate in the Celebration without any disruption of classes as stipulated in DepEd Order 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.

4. Expenses relative to the conduct of activities during the weeklong Celebration shall be charged to local funds of the concerned offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. All regional and division offices shall submit a report on the conduct of activities celebrating the 2013 Education Week **on or before January 15, 2014** addressed to the **Office of Undersecretary Dina S. Ocampo**, DepEd Central Office, Ground Floor, Rizal Building, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.

SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

1. Simultaneous Flag-Raising Ceremony and Opening Program at 8:00 AM on December 9, 2013
(The program shall be highlighted by an inspirational talk of highest official present who will talk about the salient features, aims, advantages and updates on the implementation of the Enhanced Basic Education Program or the K to 12 Program. *Parents, Barangay Officials and the Community* will be invited to attend. Consultation can also be done in addition to the orientation.)
2. Putting Up of Bazaars/Exhibits Showcasing Outputs of Pupils and Students in EPP/TLE/TVE
3. Seminar/Training/Workshop/Team-Building for Teachers and Students
4. Exhibits of Outstanding Achievements, Science Investigatory Projects and Other Projects
5. Awarding of Outstanding Teachers, Employees, Programs and Projects and Awarding of Certificates of Appreciation to all Partners, LGUs, NGOs, PTAs and Sponsors
6. Academic and Co-Curricular Contests
7. Tree-Planting, Tree-Growing and Tree-Caring Activity to be led by the Youth for Environment in Schools-Organizations (YES-O)
8. Discussions, mini-lectures or presentations with students and teachers on disaster risk reduction and related life-skills: disaster preparedness, preventive measures and behavior during and after a disaster
(This program aims to create awareness among children on the value and role of the education system in protecting them in disaster situations and provides practical information on the said topic.)
9. Balik Paaralan
(The Supreme Student Governments and Supreme Pupil Governments will serve as teachers to out-of-school youth, street children and others. Officers may give books, papers, pencils, pens and other school materials.)
10. Run for Education
(The funds collected will help in renovating school buildings destroyed by recent typhoon Yolanda.)
11. Conduct of Brigada Eskwela
12. Pasko Na!
(Schools and offices will conduct a pre-Christmas activity such as gift giving. Beneficiaries should come from poor communities, orphanages and others.)
