1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 126 entitled *Declaring The Month of December of Every Year as Rizal Month*, the Commissioner of the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) as Chairman together with the officials of all government agencies and government-owned and controlled corporations are enjoined to give full support, assistance and cooperation to the National Steering Committee (NSC) to achieve the objectives of this Celebration.

2. This year's Celebration aims to:


- a. give the youth a chance to fully recognize the value of historical events, especially the martyrdom of Dr. Jose P. Rizal, which shaped the nation and constituted the soul of the people, giving meaning to their collective life and aspirations;
- b. inspire the Filipino people to keep the lofty ideals and teachings of the national hero to stay alive in their hearts and minds;
- c. know the significance of Rizal's life and the lessons on nationalism, civic consciousness and the importance of education for Filipino youth of today; and
- d. utilize artistic and cultural activity to promote and educate the pupils and students on the essence of Filipino literacy classics in their lives.

3. To make this commemoration more meaningful, all public and private school heads are encouraged to carry out activities integrated in related subject areas, such as *Sibika at Kultura*, *Heograpiya*, *Kasaysayan at Sining (HEKASI)*, *Araling Panlipunan*, *Values Education/Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao*, Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH), Filipino and English, during classroom discussions. Enclosed is the List of Activities.

4. There will be a simultaneous Flag Raising and Wreath-laying Ceremonies on December 30, 2013 at 7:00 a.m. in the following sites and venues:

- a. National Capital Region (NCR): Rizal National Monument, Rizal Park, Manila;
- b. Region IV-CALABARZON: Rizal Shrine, Calamba City;
- c. Region IX: Rizal Shrine, Dapitan City; and
- d. Various Cities and Municipalities.

5. Teachers who will attend to this activity shall be given one (1) day service credit as per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003.
6. Expenses for the meals of DepEd employees during the Flag Raising and Wreath-laying Ceremonies and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
