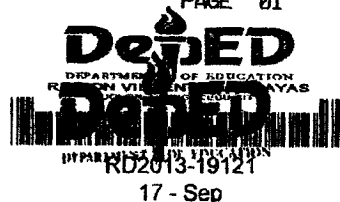



SUBJECT : PROVISIONS ON THE CONDUCT OF SPORTS COACHING/
TRAININGS/SEMINARS/OFFICIATING/ACCREDITATIONS

DATE : September 16, 2013

This has reference to the various requests from the regional/division offices regarding the conduct of regional or division sports training, seminar, officiating, and accreditation. However, several complaints were raised by the participants regarding expensive registration fees in the conduct of said activities. The teachers and the coaches even spend personal money just to be able to attend these sports activities.

In view thereof, the following provisions are hereby imposed to help the teachers and the coaches in their financial burden in attending these events:

- a. The accreditation of officiating officials shall be conducted at the national level, hence, no regional and division accreditation shall be held.
- b. All trainings and seminars and other related sports activities that require registration fee from the participant shall be charge to local/school funds including transportation and other allowable expenses, subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- c. Minimal registration fee which shall be charged to each participant covers board and lodging and training kit only.
