Good afternoon Dr. Dulangon,

Our organization aims to help teachers to fight for their rights and welfare. It is also our advocacy to help in safeguarding the credibility and the efficiency of service that our department wishes to uphold. In view of this, we would like to call the attention of your office on some issues and concerns that many school heads/ administrators intentionally ignored. Your office have been vigilant on the transparency issue of the department. Unfortunately we received reports that many school heads "ignored" and "neglect" a memo and direct order re Transparency Bulletin Board. The department's action on issuing such order is undeniably a proof that our department wanted to have a clean and transparent public service. However such aspirations and compassion did not reach the school and some divisions. Many illegal actions and practices still persist in spite of order or memo issued regarding the matter. The following are the report that our office have been receiving:

1. There are reports that many school heads took a picture of the transparency board and passed it as compliance to such order, but after taking a picture they immediately took it off.
2. There are some school heads who did not put a bulletin board and was even awarded for efficient liquidation of their MOOE.
3. Some school heads put their transparency board inside their office or near their office (which is the opposite of what is stipulated in the guidelines that it should be placed in areas far from the principal's office and can easily be seen by many people.)
4. Many reports have been sent to our office regarding the corruption of many school heads.

We will appreciate it if your office will look and investigate this matter. Service and transparency should be prioritized.
