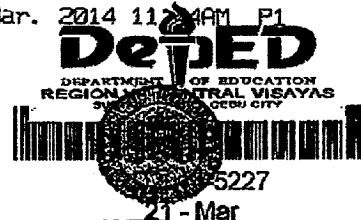

We are pleased to inform you that the Development Academy of the Philippines is now accepting nominations to the enhanced Senior Executives Class of the Public Management Development Program.

As a key agency of the national government, we would like to invite you to nominate to the new Senior Executives Class high performing third level executives from your central and regional offices, bureaus and attached agencies. Eligible for nomination are non-CESO incumbents and OICs of SG 25 positions and up, not more than 55 years old, in good health and willing and capable to undergo the rigors of the Program.

Cognizant of the core competencies expected of senior career executives in the face of recent and emerging public sector challenges, the revised Senior Executives Class is a compact course on public management delivered in 2-week segments per month over 3 months and 1 week. It features a total of 24 days intensive residential training at the Development Academy of the Philippines Conference Center in Tagaytay City, a 10-day sensing journey in a rural community and a 5-day foreign study mission in an ASEAN-member country. At the end of the course, participants are expected to submit either a policy paper or a management case drawn from the experience of the whole course.

Senior Executives Class Batch 3 will open in May 2014 while Batch 4 will commence in August. As with all PMDP classes, accepted applicants will enjoy a full scholarship from the national government.
