1. In line with the implementation of the Greening Philippines Project under the National Greening Program (NGP) for CY 2014, this Office will conduct a Tree-Growing Re-Echo Seminar to all districts of Cebu Province. (Please see attached schedule of this Memorandum) for reference.

Definition of Terms:

- 1 **Dominant species** is characterized by its height dominance. The crown is usually on top of all species.:
- 2 **Co-dominant species** are usually occupying the second strata in terms of height. These are the most dominant in terms of canopy occupation.
- 3 **Climbers** species are vines or vine like species that are dependent on dominant and codominant species. Example is rattan
- 4 **Crawlers** are creeping type species that are usually living in the soil horizon but continuously grow horizontally. Example are Sweet potato
- 5 **Shade loving species** are species that can thrive below the canopy. They can live even with minimal sunlight for their growth
- 6 **Shrubs** are species that attain short height like 1 to 2 meters. Example is coronitas
- 7 **Gap fillers** are species that resemble grass that filled-up any vacant space left after growing all the species mentioned above
