SINING SA ESKWELA ADVANCED WORKSHOP PROJECT BRIEF

Description

The Sining sa Eskurela (SSE) is an arts education training program for public school teachers specifically those with Special Program in the Arts. This program provides arts experience to the teachers, through trainors' training workshops, lecture-demonstrations, exhibitions and performances, film/video showings as well as cliniquing, mentoring, arts management, professional development and teacher wellness.

For 2014, the CCP Arts Education Department will offer Advanced SSE Workshop focusing on the enhancement and broadening of the artistic vocabulary, concepts, tools and skills with special focus on the K to 12 curriculum. This workshop is especially designed to provide teachers through various artistic experiences the opportunity to discuss relevant topics on research, pedagogical practices, and the current context of teaching and learning. Invited to attend are SPA teachers who have already attended the SSE Basic Arts Training conducted by CCP or other recognized arts institutions like NCCA.

The Advanced SSE Workshop for SPA teachers aims to:

- 2. Enhance the artistic skills of SPA teachers by providing them advanced training in their respective art forms,
- 2. Integrate cultural concepts that would develop the Filipino perspective in art production.
- 3. Offer a range of experiences in traditional and contemporary arts, from a variety of cultural and individual perspectives.
- 4. Prepare teachers to develop artistic processes that would help them to seek out and solve pedagogical issues by using critical thinking skills and innovative approaches for the K to 12 curriculum and the challenges that its forthcoming implementation presents.



 Plan, supervise & implement a 5 day - "Advanced Sining sa Eskwela" workshop for SPA teachers. 	Each region should recommend endorse 8- SPA teachers who have already attended the CCP's SSE Basic Arts Training or other recognized art institutions (i.e. NCCA, etc.)
 Provide the services of the required CCP resource persons/speakers and staff to render all the planned activities. 	Issue a memorandum to all concerned for wide dissemination of the workshop.
 Contract & pay for the honorarium/professional fees of the resource persons/speakers for the workshops, lecture- demos, interactions, etc. 	Participants shall pay for the registration fee of P3,500.00 (inclusive of workshop materials, supplies and kits) Charge against Division/School MOEE and local funds.
