**SPECIAL CONFERENCE OF PRIVATE SCHOOLS UNDER
TEMPORARY GOVERNMENT PERMIT**

TO : Assistant Superintendents
Division Supervisors/Coordinators
Private School Presidents, Principals and Registrars

1. In line with the Division of Cebu Province's effort to streamline and fast track the processing of permit to operate private schools, this Office announces the conduct of a **SPECIAL CONFERENCE OF PRIVATE SCHOOLS UNDER TEMPORARY GOVERNMENT PERMIT** on June 27, 2014 at the Executive Dining Hall of Ecotech Center, Cebu City from 8: 00 o'clock in the morning until 5: 00 o'clock in the afternoon.
2. The objectives of the one-day conference are the following:
 - a. Revisit the revised guidelines of the private schools operations in the basic education;
 - b. Prepare and check the basic requirements for the application of government permit and government recognition; and
 - c. Discuss related issues and concerns relative to private school operations.
3. Participants to the activity can either be the Private School President, School Principal or School Registrar who is directly in charge or knowledgeable about the preparation of the application documents for permit or recognition. Please see the attached list of private schools with temporary permit. Schools with temporary permit status but are not listed are likewise required to attend.
4. The participants to the conference shall bring their folders containing the school's application documents for government permit to operate or government recognition. A photocopy of the school's latest approved permit shall also be submitted during the said conference.

Expenses incurred by the private school participants shall be chargeable against private school funds, while travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the Division Education Supervisor-in- Charge of Private Schools shall be chargeable against Division INSET Funds.

6. This Memorandum shall serve as Travel Authority of all the participants.

7. Wide dissemination, preferential attention and strict compliance of this Memorandum is desired.
