MONTHLY SCHEDULE OF TREE GROWING AND GREENING DAY SY 2014-2015

To: Assistant Superintendents

Education Supervisors/Coordinators

District Supervisors/OICs

Elementary and Secondary Schools Heads

- 1. For efficient and effective implementation of the National Greening Program (NGP), the following schedule for Tree Growing and Greening Day should be followed:
 - June 28, 2014 (Run to Plant)
 - July 26, 2014
 - August 30, 2014
 - September 27, 2014
 - October 25, 2014
 - November 29, 2014
 - December 27, 2014
 - January 31, 2014
 - February 28, 2015
 - March 21, 2015
- 2. The DepEd –RAFI partnership for SY 2014-2015 is initiating June 28, 2014 as Run to Plant (R2P) wherein Nurturance of seedlings in the nursery should be part of the said activity.
- 3. The school sites are the priority planting areas, but the sites stipulated in the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) by the DA, DENR, Private individuals and LGUs shall also be used.
- 4. Fruit /Forest/Endemic tree seedlings shall be prepared and taken care of in all nurseries. In addition, planting information drive shall be conducted by the Focal persons, EPP/TLE teachers to all pupils, students, teachers and stakeholders who are involved in the said activity.

- 5. Monitoring of growing tree shall be done by all elementary and secondary pupils/students, teachers/DepEd personnel. Submission of monthly reports to this Office using Forms A and B is expected right after the Tree Growing and Greening Day and the quarterly reports using the national forms. (Attention: Mr. Romualdo C. Abella, Division HELE Supervisor or Mrs. Rosanna U. Godinez, for both elementary and secondary schools).
- 6. Consolidated reports on Greening and Tree- Growing Day shall form part of the requirements for graduation of both grade VI and K-12 graduating students. The said reports shall also be the required documents for promotion of teachers, school heads and district supervisors. There shall be a regular inspection on site and validation of data on the number of growing trees by the district NGP Focal Persons, LGUs, Our Cebu Sustainable Project Team, RAFI Greening Philippines and the Division/Regional Team Personnel.
- 7. In view of the foregoing activities, this Office shall grant Service Credits to teachers concerned.

8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
