Dear Madam:

It is our pleasure to inform you that the **University of Cebu**, one of the largest universities in the Philippines, has provided **scholarship and financial assistance to more than seven thousand (7,000)** poor and deserving students granted by the university Scholarship Program.

Particular to our Maritime Scholarship, we have partnered with both local and international agencies, like, the **Norwegian Ship-owners Association (NSA)**, **Interorient Navigation Company (INC)** and Study Now Pay Later Program of **Briese and Marlo Shipping Company** to realize dreams of many youth for globally competitive education. This means that if a student is accepted to the **Maritime International Scholarship Grants**, he/she will enjoy full scholarship (tuition, miscellaneous and all school fees, free board and lodging and free books) for the first two (2) years and will be on actual shipboard training on a foreign vessel on his 3rd year with allowance ranging from \$450.00 - \$500.00 a month. Part of this allowance would be used to pay for his/her 4th year tuition. Immediately after passing the board examination, the student would be hired as an officer by the sponsoring ship owners.

Currently, a Ship Captain or Chief Engineer is receiving a pay of **not less than \$6,000.00 or Php.288,000.00 a month.**


It is in this connection that we humbly appeal and request you to allow us to visit the public and private secondary schools in Region VII to present and discuss these scholarships and financial assistance of the University of Cebu to the graduating High School students on August 12, 2013.

Attached herewith is the Schedule of UC Teams' visit to the different public and private secondary schools and the schedule of the **Qualifying Examinations for NSA, IMEC and INC Scholarship and Entrance Examinations for Nursing Students in the Testing Centers** in your Region.

We will be forever grateful if you can also disseminate this information in a form of Regional Memorandum to all your School Division Superintendents.


