Establishment of a School Branch

To: Schools Division/City Superintendents Officers-in-Charge of Regular and Interim Divisions **Education Supervisors-in-Charge of Private Schools Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors** Private Schools Administrators

Section 41 of the Amendments to the 2010 Revised Manual of Regulations for Private Schools in Basic Education (DepED Order No. 11, s. 2011) stipulates the following provision:

There is no need for a school branch to incorporate or have a separate corporate identity for the establishment of a school branch. Educational institutions shall not be required to secure approval from the Regional Director concerned to establish a school branch, except in the National Capital Region. However, the said Regional Director shall make sure that such a school branch complies with the standards and requirements set by the Department.

Statements 6 and 7 of Section 19.3 of the 2010 Revised Manual of Regulations for Private Schools in Basic Education (DepED Order No. 88, s. 2010) stipulates the following provision:

Consistent with the national educational policies, plans and standards, the Schools Division Superintendents shall have the authority, accountability and responsibility for the following provision:

- Promoting awareness of and adherence by all schools and learning centers to accreditation standards prescribed by the Secretary of Education;
- · Supervising the operations of all public and private elementary, secondary and integrated schools, and learning centers.
- 3. The Schools Division Superintendents are thus directed to do the following:
 - 3.1 Instruct the Division Supervisor In-Charge of Private Schools to:

- 3.1.1 conduct an ocular inspection of school branches that are established in their respective Schools Divisions
- 3.1.2 require the School Head to submit the following documents to ensure that the School branch complies with the standards and requirements set by the Department:
 - · Government Recognition of the main school
 - SEC Registration of the main school
 - Board Resolution to establish a School branch
 - Documents showing ownership of the branch site and certificate of occupancy
 - Credentials of the School Head and teachers of the school branch
 - Class programs of the School branch which comply with the prescribed DepEd curriculum
 - SSS, Philhealth, and PAGIBIG Registration of the school branch personnel
- 3.2 Endorse to the Regional Director the Ocular Inspection Report supported by the School branch documents listed in 3.1.2.
- 4. The orderliness of the documents of the school branches and the recommendation of the Schools Division Superintendents based from the ocular inspection reports of the Division Supervisors In-Charge of Private Schools shall serve as bases in acknowledging the validity of the operations of these school branches.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
