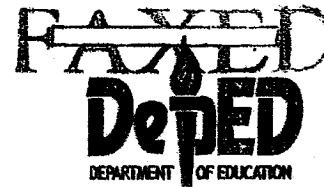

1. Pursuant to DepED Advisory No. 266, s. 2014, the Philippine National Research Center for Teacher Quality (RCTQ), a research center established by the Australian Government through the University of New England SiMERR National Research Center in partnership with the Philippine Normal University, the National Center for Teacher Education (NCTE) will conduct a national data gathering for its project dubbed as **Teacher Development Needs Study (TDNS)**.

2. The RCTQ aims to conduct research projects that could provide evidence-based and policy-relevant advice on how to strengthen teacher quality in the Philippines in support of the K to 12 Reform.

3. In particular, the Teacher Development Needs Study (TDNS) aims to determine what the teachers know and actually do that could inform DepED on the development needs of teachers and on policies and programs in strengthening teacher quality in the Philippines.
