In response to Typhoon Luis, the Department recently sent revised Rapid Assessment of Damages Report (RADaR) forms 1 and 2 for affected divisions to fill out and submit to the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (DRRMO) for consolidation (please see Annex 1 for a sample copy). The results of the RADaR will be the basis for the detailed assessment of damages and needs in TY Luis and TS Mario - affected areas.

In order to ensure that all schools have reported damages to the DRRMO, we are sending you a copy of consolidated reports sent by affected schools and divisions (please see Annex 2). Divisions with incomplete or no submission should send a signed certification from the SDS stating that the remaining schools without RADaR did not incur damages and were not used as evacuation centers. Conversely, divisions that have additional schools for inclusion in the consolidated RADaRs should submit an update on or before 10 October, Friday. All schools without RADaRs will be considered not affected by Typhoon Luis and/or Tropical Storm Mario. Respective regions should ensure that all divisions comply to this memorandum.

PREEMPTIVE ADVISORY FOR SCHOOLS IN PREPARATION FOR TROPICAL DEPRESSION (TD) LUIS (FOR REGION I, II, III, IV-A, IV-B, V, NCR, AND CAR)

September 12, 2014

As per PAGASA 24-Hour Public Weather Forecast, as of 4:00 am pf 12 September, Tropical Depression (TD) "Luis" was estimated based on all available data at 1,050 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (14.0°N, 135.0°E) with maximum winds of 45 kph. It is forecasted to move West Northwest at 30 kph. The following positions are forecasted in the next three days: by Saturday morning, TD Luis will be 660 km East of Infanta, Quezon; Sunday morning 40 km North of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan or 50 km South of Aparri, Cagayan; and, Monday morning 640 km West of Itbayat, Batanes.

In anticipation of TD Luis, all Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents, DRRM Focal Persons, and school heads of Region I, Region II, Region III, Region IV-A, Region IV-B, Region V, NCR and CAR are advised to prepare and take precautionary measures. Please take note of the following:

- 1) All RD's, SDS's and school heads are reminded to work with their respective school communities
  - é) computers and other electrical equipment are unplugged; and,
  - b) textbooks, and other important records and materials are moved to safe areas.
- 2) Additionally, the following measures should also be undertaken as appropriate with the help of the local community or LGU:
  - a) secure roof beams with wires or heavy duty ropes;
  - b) board up jalousies and windows with plywood or other secure material; and
- c) prune trees especially those adjacent to buildings and along electrical posts
- 3) For schools that may be designated by LGUs as evacuation centers, school heads should immediately contact their respective Division Offices via text message and identify the DepEd school coordinator and contact details.

While TD Luis is incide the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR), all DRRM Focal Persons are advised to stay alert and to monitor the effects of the tropical depression, RD's and SDS's are likewise advised to report regularly via SMS the status of their whereabouts. Everyone should observe necessary class suspensions based on LGU announcements and EO No. 66, z. 2012.
