**SUBJECT : 2014 NATIONAL CHILDREN'S SCIENCE INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP
(NCSIW 2014)**

**TO : School Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary Schools**

1. The **Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs, Inc. (PSYSC)** announces its **2014 National Children's Science Interactive Workshop (NCSIW 2014)** for elementary school students which will be held on **December 16-19, 2014** in **Villa Alfredo's Resort, San Fernando, Pampanga**.
2. PSYSC is a national organization that promotes the public understanding of science, technology and the environment. It supports science and technology education through lectures and seminars and interactive activities for students and teachers.
3. Equipped with the theme, **"*ENGINIUM: Transforming the City of Zepherum*"**, this year's NCSIW will focus on understanding the fundamental concepts and current trends and breakthroughs in the field of **Engineering**. NCSIW 2014 also aims to promote research and development among elementary students by showcasing inventions and discoveries of budding student engineers critical thinkers. Other activities that will be featured are series of lectures and workshops, exposure trips and other educational and fun-filled activities.
4. Each science club may send elementary school students accompanied by their teacher-adviser. Enclosed are the guidelines and information regarding NCSIW 2014.
5. The registration is **Php 5,000** for PSYSC affiliated schools and **Php 8,000** for non-affiliated schools. This is inclusive of NCSIW kits, shirt, educational trip expenses, insurance, board and lodging from dinner of December 16 to breakfast of December 19. The registration fee, travel expenses and other incidental expenses to this activity are chargeable against local school funds, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The organizers will not shoulder the accommodations of the delegates who will be staying beyond December 16-19, 2014.
6. Participants are expected to bring their own beddings, towels, toiletries, working clothes and rubber shoes (t-shirts, shorts, pants, comfortable clothes), all white outfit for the Pledge Night, native delicacies with containers for Pasalubong Festival, drinking water containers, mosquito lotion and personal medicines or other needs for allergies or other medical conditions.
7. **Deadline of submission of registration forms is on November 14.** A reservation fee of **Php 750** (deductible from registration fee) is required and is payable at **Landbank of the Philippines** account number **0702-1020-65** or remitted through **Postal Money Order (PMO)** payable only to the **Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs**. Reservation fees may be paid until **November 14, 2014**.
8. The organizers reserve the right to accept or reject registration of participants.
