- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Health and Nutrition Center (HNC), shall implement the Gulayan sa Paurulan Program (GFF), in partnership with the Department of Agriculture-Bureau of Plant Industry (DA-BPI), in address malautrition and promote vegetable production and consumption among school children.
- The Culcyan sa Pasadan shall be implemented primarily in all public elementary and according echools nationwide. Prioritization of schools will be based on the presence of at least furce of the following considerations:
 - a. high prevalence of malnutrition based on nutritional status and line report of the previous school year;
 - to high poverty incidence of the area (belongs to fourth, fifth and sixth cause municipalities);
 - c. 4Fe imacliciavies;
 - ്. tow മാമരണ്ട് performance of school (below 75% proficiency levels);
 - so. pressured of agive stabelablders.
- 5. 1 The action head (SH) is expected to monitor the activities and program improvementation. The division Technical Working Group (TWG) is expected to impositor compliance of the schools to the guidelines, procurement process, release and dishursament of funds and other activities, such as channeling of vegetables and the decimal recognam, waste negregation and composting.
- The regional TWO is expected to monitor the activities of the division office (DO) such as the regrest for funds, submission of required documents from the schools, release of funds to the SHs, on time use of funds, conduct of trainings in coordination with DA-RFU, progress of implementation, and liquidation of funds.
- 5. The schools implementing the GPP are required to submit Quarterly School Garden Report to the DO. The DOs are expected to consolidate the quarterly expects and then submit to the regional office (RO) to be followed by the final rebuissions to Depild Control Office (CO) and to DA-Regional Field Unit (RFO).

- 6. All regional directors (RDs), schools division/city superintendents (SDSs) and Sits are empired to extend full administrative support to the management of the program.
- 7. The Guidelines on the Implementation of the GPP is enclosed for ready reference.
- 3. Semerliate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
