1. To start the New Year with optimism and a renewed sense of fulfillment in teaching, all school personnel are encouraged to be in a positive disposition and to wear a smile when they report to their respective classes. 1. A Screening Committee composed of PJ Lhuillier Group Officers and Managers will shortlist the nominees to determine the Top 20 Semi-Finalists.
2. The Top 20 Semi-Finalists will be forwarded to the Board of Judges who will select the Top 10 Finalists.
