March 12, 2015	Grade 6 pupils of Private and Public Schools

2. Relative to this, this Office will conduct an **Orientation on the Administration of the National Achievement Test (NAT) School Year 2014 – 2015 on Monday, February 16, 2015 at DepED Ecotech Center, Pavillon, Sudlon, Lahug, Cebu City.**

3. Participants to this orientation are arranged as follows:

Morning – 8:00 to 12:00

- **Public Schools District Supervisors/OICs**
- **District Guidance Coordinators**
- **Private Elementary School Heads**

Afternoon – 1:00 to 5:00

- **Secondary Lead Principals**
- **Secondary Lead School Guidance Teachers/Counselors**
- **Private Secondary School Heads**

4. One (1) meal and one (1) snack will be served to the participants during the orientation, chargeable against **NETRC/Division funds** subject to their availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Participants to this orientation, in return, will conduct their district and municipal orientation to their school heads and teachers who will serve as Chief and Room-Examiners in the administration of the National Achievement Test (NAT) and Language Assessment for Primary Grades (LAPG) in their respective school districts and municipalities.
