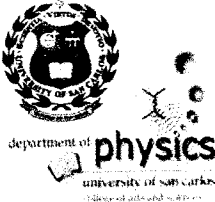


Greetings! The Department of Physics of the University of San Carlos will hold a two-day seminar -workshop on April 24-25, 2015, at the Department of Physics, Arnoldus Science Building, USC-Talamban Campus. The theme of the seminar-workshop "*Developing Capability and Confidence in Physics Teaching*" intends to cater to particular teaching needs of high school and college Physics teachers and would-be Physics teachers. The Department is conscious of its role in the community, so on its own little way, it will try to assist the participants prepare their students for college study in the STEM disciplines.


Registration will be from 6:30 A.M. to 8:00 A.M. A registration fee of five hundred fifty pesos (PhP 550.00) will be collected to cover seminar kit, lunch, light refreshments, and attendance certificate. As an option, participants can purchase two sets of equipment, one set for Mechanics and Optics experiments worth PhP 600.00, and one for Basics Circuits worth PhP 800.00. Meanwhile, early birds can avail of a PhP 500.00 registration fee if they pre-register on or before March 25, 2015. Please find enclosed the registration form. This can be photocopied and filled out by interested teachers and then mail to the Physics Department.

In this regard we humbly ask your good office to endorse this seminar-workshop to all public high school Physics teachers or would-be Physics teachers in Cebu City. We are targeting 80 to 100 participants, on a first-come first-serve basis. Interested teachers can pre-register or register on the day of the seminar-workshop. Furthermore, we suggest that teacher-participants' registration be charged from their respective school's Maintenance and other Operating Expenses (MOOE) or their Parents-teachers association (PTA).




