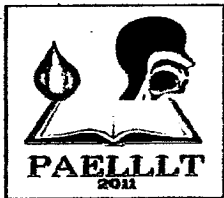

The target participants are the school administrators, coordinators, English, Reading, and Literature teachers across grade levels, Education students, and other interested individuals.

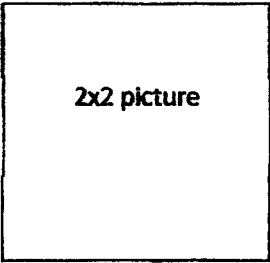

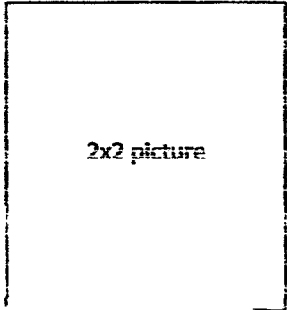
