1. Pursuant to the unnumbered DepEd Memorandum from Dir. Jocelyn DR Andaya, Director III, Concurrent Officer-in-Charge, Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), dated February 9, 2015, the Department of Education (DepEd) in partnership with the Confucius Institute at Angeles University Foundation (CI-AUF) shall conduct the **2015 Summer Training Course for Batch 4 SPFL- Chinese Mandarin teachers on April 13- May 15, 2015 at the Angeles University Foundation** to capacitate and enhance teachers' FL pedagogical skills in order to:

- develop students' skills in listening, reading, writing, speaking and viewing as fundamental to acquiring communicative competence in a second foreign language;
- prepare students for meaningful interaction in a linguistically and culturally diverse global workplace; and
- develop understanding and appreciation of other peoples' culture.

2. The participants to this Summer Training are the SPFL-Chinese Mandarin teachers of Batch 4 (see enclosed list) of the schools implementing the program. *These teachers shall be given service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers and shall be exempted from the Brigada Eskwela.* All teacher-participants are requested to secure a health certificate from a government physician indicating that they are fit to travel and/or attend the summer activity.

Accommodation, meals and training costs are taken care of the CI-AUF while traveling and other incidental expenses, including Per Diem (one day before and one day after) shall be charged to DepEd-HRTD Funds which may be supported by the Local Funds/School MOOE/SEF/PTA & other available funds in the school, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

CI-AUF will shoulder the registration, tuition fees, accommodation, books, uniforms and expenses for the 1 1/2 year immersion in China.
