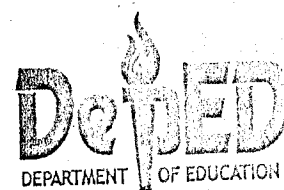

1. The Integrated Helminth Control Program (IHCP) is a priority health program jointly implemented by the Department of Health (DOH) and the Department of Education (DepEd).
