FOUR – DAY LIVE – OUT MASS TRAINING OF ALL PRIVATE SCHOOL GRADE 4 AND GRADE 10 TEACHERS FOR THE GRADE 4 AND GRADE 10 CURRICLUM OF THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM

1. To ensure smooth and unified implementation of the Grade 4 and Grade 10 Curriculum in the K to 12 Basic Education Program, there will a **FOUR – DAY LIVE – OUT MASS TRAINING OF ALL PRIVATE SCHOOL GRADE 4 AND GRADE 10 TEACHERS FOR THE GRADE 4 AND GRADE 10 CURRICLUM OF THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM** on May 25 – 28, 2015 at Ecotech Center, Lahug, Cebu City.
2. The training aims to:
 - a. Orient private school grade 4 and grade 5 teachers on the content of the K to 12 Grade 4 and Grade 10 Curriculum;
 - b. Capacitate Grade 4 and Grade 10 private school teachers in the implementation of the Grade 4 and Grade 10 Curriculum adhering to the Policy Guidelines of the Department;
 - c. Enhance Grade 4 and Grade 10 private school teachers' capacity to evaluate and administer assessment tools for the learners consistent with the existing DepEd Assessment Policy
3. Participants to the training are Private School Grade 4 and Grade 10 Teachers for school year 2015 – 2016. All participants are encouraged to bring along with them learning references, like books and modules used by the school. School Heads are requested to send the names of their participants using the attached format in order to help the Committee in the preparation of the materials and venue.
4. A registration of **FOUR THOUSAND PESOS (P 4, 000. 00)** shall be collected by the CEDAPSA Board to defray expenses for the food, rental of the venue, honoraria, materials, kits and other incidental expenses of the training chargeable against private school funds.
5. Wide and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired. This Memorandum serves as **Travel Authority** of the participants.
