DepEd MEMORANDUM 57 No. , s. 2015

DEFERRED IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GENERAL WEIGHTED AVERAGE (GWA) POLICY OF PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO TO SCHOOL YEAR 2015-2016

To: **Bureau Directors**

This is in reference to the Department of Social Welfare and Development 1. (DSWD) National Advisory Committee (NAC) Resolution No. 18 entitled Continued Support for the Child Beneficiaries of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program to Finish High School, Section 7: Repetition and Required General Weighted Average (GWA) which states that:

"Children in elementary who repeat a year level in school are allowed to continue with the program. Children in high school are required by the end of the school year to reach the passing GWA prescribed by Department of Education (DepEd), and/or promoted to the next year level."

- Initially, the abovementioned policy was scheduled to take effect at the end of School Year (SY) 2014-2015. However, several discussions were made to assess its implications specially the following:
 - a. There is a need to test the Information Technology (IT) system for monitoring the GWA of high school students under the Pantawid Pamilya (P2) Program; and
 - b. There is an on-going open selection activity that allows households to select the children who will be monitored by the program for education conditionalities, therefore leading to the possibility that the policy on GWA might influence the decision of the parents as to which child they would select to be monitored under the program.
- In view of the identified challenges, the implementation of the GWA Policy will be deferred to end of SY 2015-2016. However, the DSWD will still capture information on GWA for high school beneficiaries for the SY 2014-2015 to generate baseline data and to test the IT system for compliance monitoring. corresponding changes in the Compliance Verification Form 2 were included for P2 monitoring. The baseline data will be collected this year to serve as input for further improvement of the implementation of the said policy.

- 4. Enclosed for ready reference is the sample Compliance Verification Form 2 with the corresponding modifications and DSWD IEC materials on *Pantawid Pamilya* GWA Policy.

PANTAWID PAMILYA GWA POLICY

A guide document for partner teachers


PURPOSE OF THE DOCUMENT:


Starting school year 2015-2016, the implementation of the General Weighted Average (GWA) Policy of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program will be enforced. Thus, all children beneficiaries in HIGH SCHOOL by the end of the said school year must have a passing GWA prescribed by Department of Education, and/or be promoted to the next level. High school students who fail, and/or required to repeat a year level will NOT be allowed to continue as child beneficiaries of the program.

As part of the preparation of the program for the implementation of the GWA Policy, a revised Compliance Verification form (CV Form 2) will be used to capture the compliance of beneficiaries on the said policy. The revised CV Form 2 will provide Pantawid Pamilya a BASELINE DATA that will help the program to further improve the implemention of the GWA Policy.

This document will serve as a guide to our partner teachers, school heads, and principals on the revised CV Form 2.

WHAT WAS ADDED IN THE CV FORM 2?





The revised CV Form 2 now includes column number 9. This is applicable to children beneficiaries in HIGH SCHOOL only.

Instruction number 9 was also added in the revised CV Form 2 explaining how to properly fill out column number 9.

**** No. 9 General Weighted Average (GWA) (For Highschool Students Only)

Shade the corresponding circle if the student failed or did not meet the DepEd GWA criteria and will not move on to the next year level.

REMEMBER:

- The GWA Policy requires only the children beneficiaries in HIGH SCHOOL to pass the GWA prescribed by Department of Education
- 2 High school students who fail to meet the required GWA (for SY 2014-2015) will still be ALLOWED to continue as children beneficiaries of the program
- Pantawid Pamilya will use the compliance data (for SY 2014-2015) on the said policy as BASELINE DATA only to further improve its implementation
- Starting SY 2015-2016, HIGH SCHOOL students who fail to meet the required GWA will no longer be monitored by the program
