

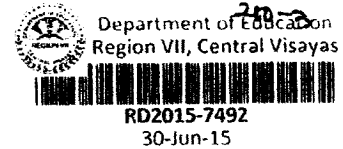



1. The Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA), a government-run special secondary school for young artists, is now accepting applications for **full scholarship** to a **Special K to 12 Secondary Education** for School Year (SY) 2016-2017.
2. The **Annual Search for Young Arts Scholars (ANSYAS)** aims to identify and develop artistically gifted and talented children to become artists of excellence in the fields of (a) ballet and folk dance, (b) creative writing, (c) music, (d) theater, and (e) visual arts.
3. Applicants must be Filipino citizens who can meet the following requirements:
 - a. Outstanding ability in dance (folk or ballet), music (instrument and voice), creative writing, theater, and visual arts;
 - b. Grade Six pupil this SY 2015-2016 in a public or private school;
 - c. Proficient in oral and written language (English and Filipino);
 - d. Good health condition;
 - e. Willing to study in a boarding school; and
 - f. Not more than 14 years old by June 15, 2016.
4. The successful applicants will be awarded full scholarship which includes free tuition fee, textbooks, board and lodging, a modest monthly stipend, individualized classes with master teachers, and a chance to represent the country in international competitions, arts festivals, and exchange programs. The scholarship is renewable every year upon satisfaction of both academic and non-academic requirements in the K to 12 Curriculum.
5. Interested applicants may directly send their accomplished application forms and other requirements by mail, email, or by personally submitting them to the Annual Nationwide Search for Young Arts Scholars (ANSYAS) Committee, PHSA, National Arts Center, Mt. Makiling, College 4031, Laguna. The PHSA Scholarship Form is enclosed.
6. The deadline for submission of applications is on **August 31, 2015**.
7. The PHSA will announce the specific venue and final dates of the screening/audition by mail. Applicants who will qualify in the preliminary evaluation will be notified by the PHSA for further assessment and live audition at a specified Regional Test and Audition Centers in Luzon, Visayas, Mindanao, and in the National Capital Region (NCR). They will be informed of the specific venue and dates of the audition by mail, and/or by email.

The School

A government-run secondary school for artistically gifted and talented children and adolescents, the Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA) implements a special secondary education curriculum and support programs aimed to train and hone future artists and cultural leaders. Aside from academic and artistic training, PHSA provides its students with opportunities to develop their social skills that will contribute to their development as artists for others. The experience of living away from home and integrating with mentors and peers in this residential high school, cultivates in the young artists an attitude of independence tempered by the spirit of cooperation. Nestled in the mystical Mt. Makiling, PHSA becomes a most ideal learning venue with its surrounding lush nature as a powerful source of inspiration for artistic endeavors among young artists and their mentors. PHSA plays a major role in nation-building with its firm belief that the artist's training and development has an impact on the socioeconomic, political and cultural realities in the country.

Search Objective

The Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA) conducts screening of applicants yearly to identify and give scholarships to artistically gifted and talented children all over the Philippines. Student applicants will go through an audition process to determine their artistic skills and talent under the supervision of the audition masters for each of the five(5) art endeavors.

Scholarship Privileges

The successful applicant is awarded free tuition fee, board and lodging (with weekend home leave with the parents or with a designated legal guardian), classes with master teachers, a monthly stipend, plus the chance to represent the country and the school in international festivals, competitions and exchange programs. The grant is renewable every year for four consecutive school years upon satisfaction of academic and non-academic requirements.

Curriculum

The Basic Education subjects prescribed by the Department of Education are in the PHSA curriculum. These subjects are handled distinctively in support of the specialized studies for creative and artistic expressions in the following disciplines:

- Creative Writing (Fiction, Poetry, Playwriting, and Journalism in English and Filipino)
- Dance (Classical Ballet, Modern Dance, Philippine Folk-Dance, Dance Composition and Staging)
- Music (Solo Voice, Songwriting, Instrument Theory, Composition, and Chamber Ensemble Classes (Chords and Chamber))
- Theater Arts (Acting, Production Management, Technical Theater, History of the Theater, Theater Theory and Directing)
- Visual Arts (Visual Perception, Sculpture, Art Appreciation, Studio Painting, Collage and Techniques, Figurative, Portray, and Printmaking)

Scholarship Eligibility

As a state-supported special secondary school, PHSA accepts only a limited number of students every year. Annual intake assesses up to 50 students only to ensure highly individualized and differentiated academic and arts training programs possible.

- To be eligible for scholarship, an applicant must:
- be Filipino citizen, with no pending application as applicant to any foreign country;
 - have an outstanding ability in a particular discipline;
 - be a graduating senior or a college student at the time of application;
 - not be older than 18 years upon application;
 - be proficient in oral and written Filipino and English;
 - be willing to study in a residential school;
 - have no debilitating illnesses or systemic and/or communicable diseases such as serum sickness, congenital heart disease, systemic lupus erythematosus, hepatitis A and/or B, untreated primary complex, chronic otitis media, malaria, bronchial asthma, and/or seizures/voluntary tremors;
 - and be determined to pursue a college degree in Dance, Creative Writing, Architecture, Fine Arts, Music, Theater Arts, Journalism, or any related courses upon graduation from PHSA.

Scholarship Requirements

The following documents must be received by the Search Committee for the preliminary evaluation of scholarship applications:

- fully accomplished PHSA Scholarship Application Form;
- photocopy of Birth Certificate issued by the NSO;
- photocopy of Grade VI Report Card;
- one-page resume of all accomplishments in the art field of interest;
- 10 samples of works (e.g. short story, poem, essay) in English and/or English written on double-spaced on A4 white bond paper as indicated by the teacher-in-charge (for creative writing);
- 10 images of art works (post-format) in CD or DVD (optional) arranged for visual arts;

Original records and other documents will not be returned to the applicant. Do not submit original copies when not required to. All applications must be received by the Scholarship Committee on or before August 31, 2019.
