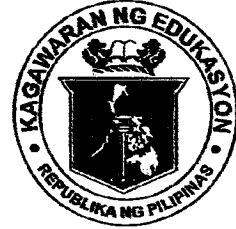

The High School Mathematics Area of Sacred Heart School – Ateneo de Cebu together with Dr. Ian June L. Garces of Ateneo de Manila University would like to hold a Seminar-Workshop on July 25, 2015 (Saturday) for the public and private High School Math Teachers in Cebu at the SHS-AdC Theater. This will be entitled “Math Pedagogy in Problem Solving and Math Competitions”. Attach herewith is the schedule of activities.

Teaching Math in the classroom is far different from training Math for competitions. While all Math teachers are expected to teach Math properly in the classroom, not all Math teachers are capable of training students for Math competitions. Less on theory, but more on the pedagogy and techniques of solving problems, this seminar workshop will supplement the teachers in coaching their students for Math competitions.

The three main goals of this seminar-workshop are:

- 1] to equip the teachers with techniques in solving problems, especially those that came out in recent Math competitions,
- 2] to enhance the ability of the teachers to ask the right questions and to create better problems by modifying and improving a given problem, and
- 3] to share best practices among teachers from the different schools in coaching students for Math competitions.


