**ANNUAL FOLKDANCE WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS  
IN THE ISLAND OF CAMOTES**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) - Division of Cebu Province announces the conduct of the Annual Folkdance Workshop for Teachers to be conducted in San Francisco Camotes, Cebu on August 7, 8, and 9, 2015.
2. The following objectives are aimed to be achieved in the workshop:
  - enhance teachers' skills and competencies in teaching folkdances while increasing their stock knowledge of folkdances to be taught to pupils and students;
  - capacitate them to effectively and efficiently contribute to the implementation of the cultural development program of this Division aligned with the K to 12 curriculum;
  - identify potential members of the Cebu Province Culture and the Arts Troupe and band members.
3. The workshop will consist of learning folkdances introduced in the National Folkdance Workshop conducted in Vigan City, Ilocos Sur by the Philippine Folkdance Society of the National Commission for the Culture and the Arts as well as lectures on dance production, costuming and staging.
4. From the folkdances taught in this Workshop, official contest piece for the Cultural Festival in the upcoming 2015 Provincial Meet shall be identified.
5. Participants to the workshop are elementary and secondary teachers in the public and private schools and folkdance enthusiasts. Participants should be physically fit to undergo strenuous activities. No pregnant participant shall be allowed.

6. Workshop participants are required to come in PE or any comfortable attire and rubber/flat shoes. However, norms of decency appropriate for educators should be observed in the choice of comfortable attire (i.e. no short pants, maong and skinny jeans, spaghetti strapped or tube blouses and the like shall be allowed).
7. This Memorandum serves as Authority to Travel of the participants.
8. A registration fee of Php 500.00 shall be charged each teacher participant and Php 300.00 for student participants to defray expenses for 2 CD's containing the music of the dances taught and literature, certificates, honoraria of resource persons, t-shirt and other operating expenses necessary for the conduct of the workshop. Registration, transportation and other expenses incurred by the participants from the public schools on account of their participation in the workshop shall be chargeable against local school/MOOE/SEF/PTA or any fund subject to their availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from the private schools can make arrangements with the administration of their respective schools on matters relative to participation expenses.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
