With this, I am anticipating your full-support to this endeavor!



Marc Helgesen is professor in the Dept. of Intercultural Studies at Miyagi Gakuin Women's University, Sendai, Japan and has been adjunct professor at Teachers College Columbia University – MA TESOL Japan program and Nagoya University of Foreign Studies where he teaches a graduate level course in Positive Psychology in English Language Teaching. Marc is author of over 150 ELT books, textbooks and articles. He has been an invited speaker at conferences on five continents and presented over 500 teaching-related workshops and presentations. He is the Chair of the Extensive Reading Foundation (www.erfoundation.org). His other professional interests include Positive Psychology in ELT and Neuroscience applications to language teaching. He is a founder of the FAB Brain Science in Language Teaching Study Group. He maintains websites at www.ELTandHappiness.com and www.HelgesenHandouts.weebly.com.



Marco holds a Master's degree in Child Psychology and a degree in Development Communication. He has been teaching children and training teachers in Japan for over 18 years. He believes learning and teaching English should be fun and easy for both non-native learners and non-native teachers. Marco is the founder and executive training director of the Institute of English Teaching to Children (IETC) and associate of International Teacher Development Institute (ITDi). He has also written several articles on games and is presently a presenter for Oxford University Press Japan.
