  - **September 18, 2015** – Oral presentation of top 3


- National Clean-up Day
  - **September 21, 2015**

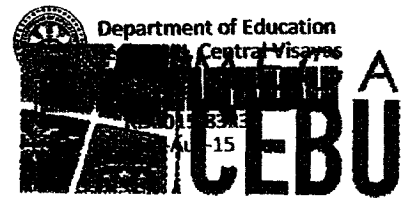
